OUR VISION

We're a community making bicycling sustainable, equitable, and affordable for everyday transportation; where human-powered transportation is prioritized and better all residents' lives physically, emotionally, and economically.

Bike Giveaway Program

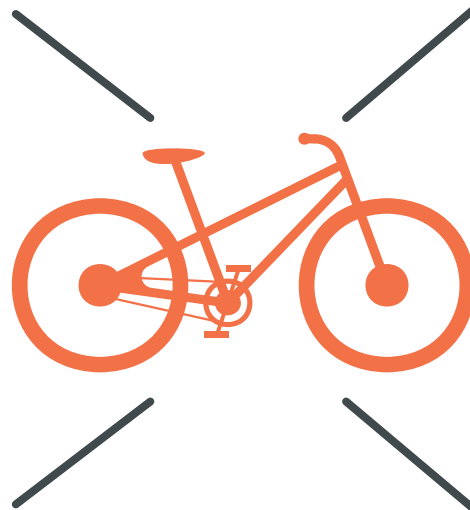
Each year, we give 2,000 bikes to people in need. Bikes help people get to work, school, access services and food. They are good for people and the planet, plus they are fun!

We accept donated bikes year-round then refurbish them with our small army of dedicated volunteers. By refurbishing bikes, we keep them out of the landfill.

Bike Education Program

Our *Bike Mechanics* educational program teaches youth how to build a bike, basic repairs, and sets the foundation for a career as a bike mechanic.

Bike mechanics are a skilled trade and always in short supply especially in bike-loving communities like Madison. They are great paying jobs and provide entrepreneurial opportunities.



Bike to Work Program

We provide fleets of bikes to organizations that serve refugees and new immigrants. Through our fleets, people with no access to transportation are able to find jobs. Ask us about our fleets and fleet repair services. Bikes are vehicles and vehicles must be regularly maintained.

Bike Sales & Service

Visit our bike shop in south Madison to shop for used bikes! You can also hire us for low-cost bike service and repairs. Our inventory features all styles with many brands available. Bikes can be purchased as-is or you can purchase them repaired. All of these options help fund our *Bike Giveaway* program and provide sustainability.

WAYS TO BE INVOLVED

VOLUNTEER: Spend a few hours cleaning or refurbishing bikes! No experience is needed. Corporate teams of 8-12 are invited to join us on Friday afternoons. Kids age 10+ are welcome with an adult. Hours are during the day Monday-Friday, or evenings (6-8pm) on Mondays and Tuesdays. Sign up on our website!

DONATE: While we receive bikes for free, it's not free to give them away. It's costly providing fully-tuned vehicles to 2,000 people each year. Without our work, many would never have the opportunity to own a bike to get to school, work, or for enjoyment. Funds are always needed.



Financial donations can be made through our website or at the bike center. Did you know you can donate a boat or a car too? We accept bike donations of all sizes and styles year-round. Bike donations should be dropped off Monday-Friday. We also offer annual memberships so you can repair your bike in our fully-equipped bike shop!

SALES & SERVICE: Purchase your used bike from us! We have all sizes and styles of high-quality bikes. You can also hire us for your repair services. Your support means you are providing someone else with a bike and provides more long-term sustainability so we can continue to give bikes to people in need.
